*Definition [a]: a commonly independent formulation of governance, synonymous with country or government.*

*Definition [b]: a region of governance akin to that of the province.*

*Definition [c]: to be and or the fact or position of being.*

# *One; The issue of entropy:*

**Entropy.** *Within a closed system, entropy will indefinitely either increase or be nullful of change. However, its entropic mass will never face the fate to be lessened. Thus, maximum entropy is inevitably the fate of all things within reality.*

*One example of this phenomenon is the organism. Nearly the entirety of organisms begin their life's nearly null of entropy. Nonetheless, little "entropic puddles" are conjurerated. They start out small, perhaps a little crack on the bone forms. Maybe a cell doesn't copy just right. Perhaps a minuscule deviance between the mental and physical realms is conjurerated. However, you must observe a fact observed in the last paragraph: "Within the closed, entropy will indefinitely either increase or be nullful of change", and thus, inevitably the bones shall be crippled and shattered. A cancerous mass forms of lethal proportions. Replacing the once perfect mental mirror lies a painting of oneself a unicorn! Next, entropy cruelly devours the organism, resulting in death.*

*Thus, there is no such occurrence of "death by old age." The true assassin is entropy and thus "death by entropy".*

*Tragically, nothing is immune to the inevitable fate that entropy conjures. Even the state is not invincible. The state is akin to the organism. The state is destined to accumulate entropy. For an example I present the Austrian Empire [later referred to in its so-called “life” as the Austro-Hungarian empire].*

*The Austrian Empire of the early 1800s, was a state to be respected. However, as the organism accumulated entropy, the empire additionally had to face the formation of its own entropic puddles.*

*One of these puddles was growing nationalism. Its threat to the empire was the lessening of imperial territory. Nationalism threatened to initiate the degradation of its imperial borders, into a reflection of ethnic lines [which would be a miracle or great misfortune, depending on who you ask]. If nationalism was a tiger, then Austria was to be its prey, and the nationalistic tiger was to conduct its onslaught in the year of 1848. During the year of 1848, rebellions rose across the Austrian realm, akin to a ravenous tumor. Austria’s attempts to vanquish the rebellions were futile. The empire pleaded to the Russian tsardom, in an act of self-preservation. The tsardom chose to spare Austria from the wrath of the tiger. Nonetheless, the Austrian monarch was abdicated. Due to Austria’s choice not to aid the Russian empire in the Crimean war, there would be no more help from the tsardom. The revolutionaries were emboldened as a chess player who had only minutes ago conquered magnus Carleson. The largest entropic puddle in the domain of possibility may have been thwarted from forming, but another mass of great magnitude had emerged.*

*Another threat was the rising Prussian empire, eclipsing Austria in Geminian politics. Which came to fruition in the Austro-Prussian war. If nationalism was a tiger, then Prussia was to be the apex of the food chain. Prussia vanquished Austria and thus claimed victory. The*

*Austrian imperium was forever humiliated and shattered into two states in a gambit of self-preservation and thus Austria-Hungary was born. The new imperium was weaker than its predecessor due to the veto power of the two states, thus making it harder to coordinate. The dual empire's position was akin to that of a person with their brain split in two.*

*Surely enough, the imperium crumbled under its own weight and the pressure of World War 1 during the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. due to its lethal entropic puddles, consuming the state resulting in death. Thus, this is the textbook example of "Death by entropy".*

*Firing a nuclear bomb would be highly inappropriate if the cause was A simple deer being consumed by entropy. However, the state's wellbeing can affect millions of people. Additionally, a state turning to tyranny is also a threat worth much consideration. In order to illustrate this claim further, I must state if you asked the goals of someone writing a constitution, they would likely say something akin to: "to avoid the state [or body of power influenced by this document] turning to the ways of tyranny and incompetence ". Or perhaps death by entropy? However, if maximum entropy is the conclusion of all things, no matter how well-oiled your document is, it will still submit to entropy. So shall we adopt nihilism as our state, no, For I present "**Flowerism**".*

# *Two; the presentation of Flowerism:*

*Flowerism; noun; the belief in commanding natural selection in order to harness entropy to modify or form systems.*

*Due to the inevitability of maximum entropy, it would be impossible to prevent the slow devouring of the state. However, entropic puddles do not necessarily have to threaten the state. Entropy is a manifestation of chaotic events resulting in unpredictability. Entropy does not only dangerous events. *An argument for this claim would be of the organism once again. During part one, we observed the organism's susceptibility to the entropic puddle. # *Three; a series of arguments for the practices of Flowerism:*

*For those who place their disbelief upon the power of Flowerism, I present a series of arguments for the practice of Flowerism. For those who do not place their disbelief upon the practice, I suggest you still read this section for the purpose of the viewing of confessions.*

*One: Those with a keen eye may have perhaps noticed there is a flaw with the threat of entropy to the state and present a confession: The state is not to be categorized as a closed system but rather an open system, possessing entropy in the form of territory, population, the economy, foreign diplomacy, stability, bureaucracy and corruption. The forms in this open system affect each other and are additionally affected by the outside of the state. However, I do not believe these operations are practical or sustainable over the long term.*

- 1. “The vent”: The vent is the process of which the state eliminates the entropy within the population through expulsion.*

*There are two ways the state expels its population: Allowing population to leave the borders of the state or banishing the population [akin to the methodologies of the Cuban state].*

- 2. Selling or surrendering the land of which the entropy is possessed [akin “cutting off the arm with cancer”].*

*I believe the former is greater in comparison to the latter [if the predicament is that of population], however the latter can combat entropy from the land and people, while the former may only combat the entropy of which rests within the population of which is the former’s field of expertise and specialization. Nonetheless, it lay within the perspective that the valve is impractical, due to the methodology of the ladder is akin to that of “cutting off the arm with cancer”. The former, though superior to the latter, appears to be far to akin. Additionally, it possesses the highest of potentials to lead past the event horizon of utter catastrophe [view the state of Cuba].*

*War: it is highly common throughout the great chronicles of history for a state to import and export the entropies of stability through the processes of war. A potential example of the imperial practice would be the Russo-Ukrainian war. The imperium of the USSR collapsed and dissolved due to internal pressures. Due to the immense collapse of the Soviet empire, it had been banished from the category of the superpower, Thus, the disgraced imperium now possessing the title of great power, with a fathomless thirst for retribution and the reconquest of its imperial glory, declared war on the state of Ukraine, a past holding of the imperium.*

*One perhaps would observe the motive of the war as one of which its goal would be categorized under that which would be a restoration of stability and imperium. That which would be to export its entropy through the proceeds of war.*

*However, the issue of this system is one which i utterly fathom and with near certainty, you to have already experienced and formulated, of which is the issue of risk. The issue of risk i deem is that war is a matter of probability. For the purposes of presentation, I shall continue with the tale of the Russo-Ukrainean war.*

*The imperium fathomed a quick and decisive invasion. However, the roll of the dice of conquest rolled the side of I. Thus, it was slow and humiliating. When i was born the state of Russia was a gargantuan and formidable beast, however, in the chronicles of the present the Russian imperium, in my eyes and likely many others, the Russian state has been demoted from great power to lesser power, and that is the risk of war*

*“The Versailles”:* “the Versailles” is coined after the palace of Versailles, used by Louis XIV in order to redirect the entropies of bureaucracy and place them to the matters of great insignificant and municipality, akin to that of the processes of “who gets to put on Loui's shoes”. Thus, centralizing the state. I must confess I have great respect for the methodologies of “the Versailles”, I would even fathom that if the proceeds of Flowerism are to be adapted, the methodology of “the Versailles” will be a reform that will collect grandeurs respect from an algorithm of Flowerism. However, the flaw is that only so much entropy may be lessened by “the Versailles”, for it is only specialized for the proceeds of bureaucracy. However, its decadence was a contributing factor in the French revolution. Perhaps one who uses the methodology shall be wary of such.

*“The mimic”:* “the mimic” is the concept that one possesses a sufficient imperium within the state’s enablement to formulate laws, in order for that one to do so oneself akin to how the proceeds of Flowerism would mandate it. However, a “the mimic” may only do so far as to perfectly conjurate the illusion of Flowerism or fail to imitate

*it. Thus, the mimic is lesser as a substitute for Flowerism. However, “mimics” are of the utmost priority of fostering, for a state that has reformed under the proceeds and customs of Flowerism.*

*Thus, the most effective and efficient form of the alleviation and minimization of entropy is the practice of Flowerism.*

*Two: I must address that a minority of you possess a valid concern that Flowerism is but a dire threat to democracy, however i do aspire if Flowerism were to be adopted, its algorithm should be based on that of democracy. Perhaps through a voting system. I additionally fathom it would be best added as a reform.*

*However, it is highly likely if the methodology of Flowerism were to be adopted, the threat that a dictatorship or regime of the totalitarian will perhaps conduct the proceeds of Flowerism to maximize the totalitarian and tyrannical lies in the range of the possible and likely. However, the hypothetical proposed state will likely use the methodology in order to maximize imperial power as well, and thus Flowerism may be the only way to confront such a threat.*

*Three: Continuing with the threat of death by entropy, I must illustrate the mechanisms of the accumulation of entropy and thus I possess and thus must present a confession. Entropy may only enter the state during an “instance of entropic growth”. During such an occurrence, one may fathom the instance as a farm failing [“instance of entropic growth”]. *Four: I must say that practices and customs quite akin to those of Flowerism have already been attempted, during the spring and autumn period. Of which conjugated a state of unfathomable power, dominated international markets for chronicles greater than 1500 years, a state of such elegance it coined itself the “middle kingdom”, a state of such prowess it collapsed due to its very ego, a state of such greatness it converted its invaders into its culture, a state of such immense prowess its imperium extended upon numerals greater than 11 imperial dynasties, dynastic *China*.*

*Upon the primordial eras of the spring and autumn period may be seen perhaps as an environment. Upon the old primeval eras of the mystical and primordial period, a kingdom of which adopted proceeds of great efficiency shall perform a conquest of its neighbors. However, once the conquering state collapsed, its proceeds would be adopted by its inheritors, repeat.*

*Additionally, upon the later chronology of the dynastic eras of the imperium, many methodologies akin to the spring and autumn period occurred. Due to the mandate of heaven, of which it is that of an origin*

*of imperial legitimacy. Nonetheless, its influence established a systemization of natural selection, of which possesses 3 phases.*

*I-China shall be utterly dissolved while within this phase, additionally upon this era, shall lay a fosteration of Flowerism.*

*II-Upon this phase a grandiose imperial dynasty develops a crucial adaptation which enables the imperium to claim the mandate of heaven.*

*III-The dominating dynasty crumbles into a gargantuan mass of rivaled imperial dominions, repeating the cyclicity.*

*Additionally, upon the very latest of dynasties of the dynastical chronology begin to commence the elimination of phase II and the start of the isolationist periods, of which decisively blocked the mass transfer of the idea, simulating a decrease of mutation. Thus, within the early 20<sup>th</sup> century the Qing Dynasty collapsed*

# *Four; the manual of the flower*

*I believe it is of the very utmost of importance that the practices of Flowerism are correctly represented within this book. Thus, I present the manual of the flower, for a state which adopts the practices and customs of Flowerism and conducts them with the ways of Flowerism. Additionally, within the most later compositions of this very section, I shall add a reform that would implement the practices and customs of Flowerism to the state.*

*One of the most important details of Flowerism is its relation to surrealism. I perhaps could have titled this book the “Neo-Surrealism Manifesto.” If you are having issues fathoming this, then I present you with a question: Which of the following would provide the highest benefit to a Flowerist society: Surrealism or the hardest of logic. If you are facing befuddlement at this moment, then I must explain.*

*Due to Flowerism involving a trial of mathematics, the most logical study, what is Flowerism to gain from logic if it is a mathematical filter.*

*Thus, boundless surrealism will feast the Floweriest, filter many great concepts and dismiss the rest. Thus, Flowerism is improved by*

*surrealism, and with the mechanisms of Flowerism, surrealism will likely prosper with Flowerism.*

*Thus: Flowerism then surrealism. Which could be translated in more mathematical terms as: Flowerism=surrealism. Additionally, the purpose of surrealism was to create a balance between the logic and innate madness of the self. I fathom it is most evident, Flowerism and Surrealism, combined, can complete this task of state far more easily than either alone. Thus, Flowerism and surrealism are but two sides; of the same coin.*

*Perhaps you still see Flowerism and surrealism as two different things. Perhaps, due to them possessing different goals. And if so, I do not believe I possess the capabilities to do so. Though I do deeply applaud surrealism [though I do not agree with all the surrealist manifesto's claims], and I do as well hope this will cement a connection between surrealism and Flowerism. The latter, a quiet major purpose for this section.*

*Now to continue with Flowerism.*

*The process of Flowerism consists of the 3 phases of Flowerism: blooming, flowering and wilting. Once completed, the 3 phases will repeat akin to cyclicity. One perhaps may reorder them, due to its feasibility.*

*Blooming: within the proceeds of blooming, terra is assigned to groves. Each grove shall act akin to an independent state; however, must be tied intrinsically with its partners, in order to maximize the state's unity and functionality.*

*It is of utmost importance that the groves do not equip themselves with nationalism, or the state's functionality will be irreversibly compromised by entropy. Thus, I suggest the very territories of the grove*

*It is of the greatest of imperative and importance i must utterly fulfill the promise of which i conjugated at the very commencement of this section [“Additionally, within the most later compositions of this very section, I shall add a reform that which would implement the practices and customs of Flowerism to the state.”]. Thus, i present the following:*

### ***Flowerism reform bill amendment [draft]:***

*[I] Divide the lands of the state by the following algorithm:*

*Each grove shall be gifted 20percent of the territories [province, county of which I adore most highly, state, etc.] of the state [divided by that of probability].*

*[IV] One shall utilize the following treaty in order to prevent the dissolution of the state by the groves*
